Safety Minute

Randy reviewed general field safety along with testing and correctly setting of transmitter fail safe to verify that in the event of a transmitter signal failure in flight the throttle would go to full off. Additionally, the use of the throttle cut-off feature and switch

was discussed and how its use would prevent unintended throttle advance.
