

## Programming Lever or Slider and Knob by Andy Kunz

*I think these are referred to as sliders. I have read the DX9 manual and they are only mentioned on the switch/adjustment locations as item 3 and 15 (left lever/right lever). No mention as to ... how to make them work.*

They're referred to as Lever or Slider. The knob isn't mentioned much either, which is equivalent to them.

The knob defaults to AUX3.

The left lever defaults to AUX4.

The right lever defaults to AUX5, but you don't have one on a DX9. You can use the Channel Input Assign to map it to a function, or you can mix directly from it to a channel (LLv and RLv are the names there).

They work on anything you want. Just like the switches, they can be used in any way that makes sense, as well as a few ways that don't.

The Monitor screen shows LLv on AUX4.

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
